"We Must Never Forget!" **ANAHEIM HILLS 911 MEMORIAL**

Mayor Tom Tait has confirmed that he will participate in Anaheim Hills Rotary's tenth anniversary of the Sept. 11, 2001 terrorist attacks. Those attacks took the lives of three Anaheim residents -- two, who lived in the Hills!

Our Club will remember them and their families Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011, along with the military and first responders of our police & fire services.

All of you have received an e-flyer from our Chair, Diane Reed, and should have forwarded it to your contacts by now.

Diane is seeking help in getting the word out to youth via **Facebook & Twitter!** If you can help her do that, please let her know immediately.

In addition to the three local men died that day. A local father of two Navy Seals will speak briefly and read the names of the 30 elite Seals who were killed in action recently when their chopper was downed by enemy fire in Afghanistan.

The 911 program will also include a flag salute, tributes to the men and women of the Armed Forces, police
