## PASKINS' WIDOW OFFERS REGRETS...

Inez Paskins, the widow of Jerrold Paskins responded to our invitation to the 9/11 vigil with sincere regrets. Her husband Jerrold Paskins was killed on 9/11 while on a three-day business trip to New York. He died in the World Trade Ctr.

"I think what you are doing in Anaheim Hills is wonderful," Mrs. Paskins said. "I will be in New York that day. I have been selected as one of the readers at that ceremony. I'll be reading the names of those who died there and I will get to read my husband's name," she said, in offering her regrets.

Mayor Tom Tait will participate in our memorial to Paskins, Christopher Newton and Chic Burlingame, local men who died in Sept. 11, 2001 terrorist attacks.

Our Club will remember them and their families and all other heros of the war on terror, including the Navy Seals who died recently. On Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011, we will also pay tribute to our first responders -- our police officers & fire fighters.
